Program Description:

The annual Community and Public Leadership Workshop will be held March 1-5, 2010 for students seeking careers in nonprofit and community based organizations, public affairs or government, activism, and social change.

The workshop has two purposes:

1. To introduce participants to the range of viable and diverse career options in public interest work;
2. To engage participants in discussions about ethical leadership and responsible citizenship in public service;
3. To prepare participants to enter public service by providing experiences and skills helpful to them and their future organizations.

The program is taught by Holy Cross alumni, faculty and staff working within a nonprofit or public affairs setting at the international, national, regional, and local levels.

Housing, books, and meals for the week-long workshop are funded by the College.
