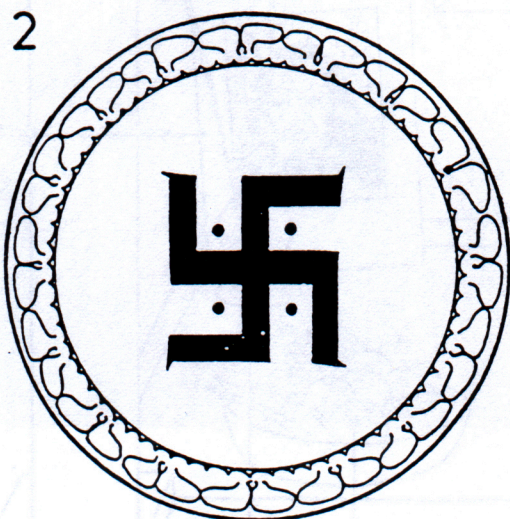


Three sacred symbols

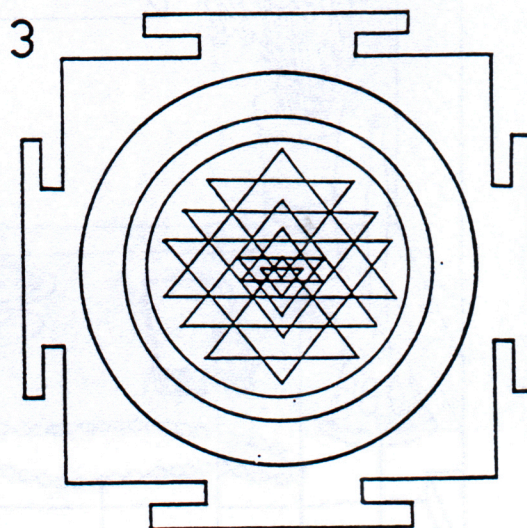

- 1 OM sacred syllable, symbol of spiritual goodness, used as a word formula on its own or to introduce other words.
- 2 Swastika, an equilateral cross with arms bent at 90 degrees, normally at right angles. In Sanskrit the word means 'conducive to well-being'. Hindus use it on doors, thresholds, account books and offerings.
- 3 Shri Yantra, a form of mandala symbolizing wholeness.
