Tashi Lama, at the request of Bhutan's Deb Raja, sent a letter of mediation to Warren Hastings, Governor-General of India, seeking cessation of British action against Bhutan resulting from Deb Raja's attack on Cooch Behar in 1772. Letter was favorably received on March 29, 1774. After brief negotiation a Treaty of Peace was signed April 25, 1774.
