5 Ways to Look at the Earth

LOCATION: Geographers begin by describing where something is...its absolute or relative location.

Subjective

PLACE: Geographers describe the physical and/or human features.

HUMAN-ENVIRONMENT INTERACTION: Geographers use this to stress how people affect their environment, the physical characteristics of their natural surroundings, and how their environment affects them.

MOVEMENT: This theme helps geographers understand the relationship among places. People, goods and ideas move from one place to another.

REGION: Geographers use the theme of regions to make comparisons. Regions have unifying characteristics, for example; climate, culture, or products.
