WORLD RELIGIONS: Introduction Vocabulary

- 1. **Religion**: "Religion is any specific system of belief about a deity or deities, often involving rituals, a code of ethics, a philosophy of life, and a worldview." (from ReligiousTolerance.org)
- 2. **Culture**: A culture is a way of life of a group of people—the behaviors, beliefs, values, and symbols that they accept, generally without thinking about them, and that are passed along by communication and imitation from one generation to the next.
- 3. **Transcendent**: Literally, to "climb beyond." To be beyond or outside the range of normal human experience
- 4. Sacred: worthy of worship in a religious way; made or believed to be holy
- 5. Profane: Normal; not sacred
- 6. Monotheism: The belief in one God
- 7. Polytheism: The belief in many gods
- 8. Henotheism: The belief in a single god without denying the existence of other gods
- 9. Atheism: Literally, "no God." A position stating that there is no God or gods
- 10. **Agnostic**: Literally, "not know." A position stating that the existence of God can't be proven
- 11. **Deity**: any supernatural being worshipped as controlling some part of the world or some aspect of life or who is the a "force" in human form
- 12. Divine/divinity: Coming from, or having the nature of, a god
- 13. **Secular**: non-religious, as in "a secular story" or a "secular university"
