General Information: Innovative Services for Latino Adolescents (ISLA) is an academic after-school program for third, fourth, fifth and sixth grade students from Chandler Magnet Elementary School and the Goddard School. This program focuses on the development and enhancement of early English literacy skills.

ISLA provides time for homework help, academic classes in literacy and mathematics, and mentorship. Students also participate in arts and crafts, field trips, and other recreational activities throughout the year. This program works to dovetail the school day curriculum by adding additional support and instruction.

When: The program runs on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 2:30-4:00PM. We only ask for students to participate one day each week, but if you would like to participate multiple days per week, it would be greatly appreciated.

Where: Mentors from Holy Cross will be going to the Goddard School and Chandler Magnet.

Transportation: Students will be picked up at Hogan 3 prior to 2:30 each day and picked up by 4:00pm.
